AWARDS LIST

Student Leader of the Year

Recognising an exceptional student who has demonstrated outstanding leadership within the university community. They have excelled in their role by inspiring others, driving positive change, and making a significant and lasting impact on students' experiences.

Society of the Year

Awarded to the society that has scored the most points in the Society Plus competition this academic year.

Officer's Choice Award

This award is chosen by the CSU Officers for a student leader or group that has worked hard to create a welcoming, safe environment and consistently takes initiative to make positive change within the University of Chester community.

AWARDS LIST

Student Activist of the Year

This award honours a student who has demonstrated passion, commitment, and leadership in driving positive change.

Whether through sustainability efforts, community action, campaigning with CSU, or activism within the University or local area, this student worked tirelessly to make things better for others and inspire those around them.

Staff Choice Award

Chosen by staff, this individual or group has stood out through their commitment, enthusiasm, and support for the work of the Students' Union and the wider student experience.

They have contributed to more than one area of student life - whether through representation, volunteering, societies, campaigns, or other involvement and have played an important role in enhancing the sense of community at the university.

AWARDS LIST

Student Event of the Year

Recognising an outstanding student-led event that made a significant, positive contribution to the University of Chester community.

Most Improved Society of the Year

This award recognises a society that has made significant improvements from previous years, including increased memberships to hosting more activities.

New Society of the Year

This award will be presented to a society formed this academic year (September 2025 onwards), and whose activities and achievements throughout the year have been successful and beneficial.

AWARDS LIST

Student Voice Rep of the Year

This award recognises an SVR who has demonstrated exceptional commitment to student voice initiatives, acted as a positive role model for their peers, and driven meaningful change within their course, department, or school. They have been consistently active and engaged in their role as a Student Voice Representative.

Above & Beyond Award

This award celebrates a student who has gone above and beyond during their time at the University.
